### GENERAL MEETINGS:

**Wednesday July 9, 2008: Priscilla Kibbee - Wearable Art Trunk Show.** Priscilla will have a trunk show of her wearable art. She has been a frequent participant in the Fairfield and Bernina fashion shows, and won numerous awards for her creations. Vendor: Priscilla Kibbee

**Friday, August 1, 2008, Karen Combs - "Quilts Of Illusions"** (slide lecture) Explore the world of optical illusions with Karen as she shows you some of the wonderful quilts that quilters have created using optical illusions. Slides and quilts of illusion complete this lecture.

**Friday, September 5, 2008 (date change), Joan Shay - "Let's Get Bonded"**. An exciting informative trunk show which features approximately 60 quilts ("in person"). Her technique Appli-bond is discussed and samples are shown.

**Friday October 3, 2008, Laura Wasilowski, Explore the artist's quirky mind with this lecture about quilt making in a series.** Enjoy the revelation that one chicken quilt will surely lead to a second, third, or fortieth. And discover what drives a person to create multiple quilts about a blue chair, garden implements, or unsung kitchen appliances. All are revealed in this expose, which includes dramatic renditions from Songs of the Fuser. Laura will display her small quilts (mini-series) and offer a trunk show of hand dyed fabric and thread from Artfabrik dyers.

### July 8 & 9, 2008 - Priscilla Kibbee - 2 day jacket class

Using a pattern without darts or set in sleeves, participants will design a one of a kind jacket using 8-10 fabrics of their choice. Several types of fabric manipulation embellishment can be incorporated in the jacket design resulting in a beautifully classic wearable jacket. The Geisha in the center of the back is needlepoint trimmed with beads, and the jacket contains a number of geisha fabrics, scrunched and embellished fabric, and sumptuous gold embellished Seminole. \$90 to members, \$100 non-members, due tonight!

### August 2, 2008 - Karen Combs - Patchwork Illusion

**Vs Visual depth** has fascinated artists for centuries, Karen has developed a quick and easy rotary technique that allows you to make quilts with a 3-D look. \$50, due at the July meeting.
